REDUCE TRAFFIC CONGESTION!

Dear Florida Legislator,

On September 30th, the annual Urban Mobility Report, published by the Texas Transportation Institute (TTI) at Texas A&M University, was released and it showed that traffic congestion levels in 75 urban areas have increased costing these communities **\$69.5 billion each year** in lost productivity and wasted fuel. **Florida had the most congested cities in the top 58 urban areas** listed. In fact, **drivers in Orlando waste more time in traffic than do New York City drivers!** The eight Florida areas with the worst traffic congestion are:

- Miami-Hialeah
- Ft. Lauderdale-Hollywood-Pompano Beach
- Orlando
- Tampa-St. Petersburg-Clearwater
- West Palm Beach-Boca Raton-Delray Beach
- Fort Myers-Cape Coral
- Jacksonville, and
- Pensacola

Delays caused by congestion rob us of the most valuable commodity any of us has ...TIME. Congestion means missed business opportunities, increased operating costs, and lost time that could have been spent with families, friends, and loved ones. That's why it is imperative that you prevent another multi-million dollar "diversion" from the Transportation Trust Fund in 2004, and encourage Governor Bush not to include a transportation diversion in his proposed budget.
