COUNTY	EXPRESSWAY & BRIDGE AUTHORITY MAKEUP
MIAMI-DADE Ch. 348 part 1 A/K/A FL Expressway Authority Act Created 1990	13 MEMBERS- 7 county residents appointed by the governing body of the county (of which 2 may be elected officials), 5 county residents are appointed by the Governor, and the FDOT Dist. Secretary (also a voting member)
BREVARD Ch. 348 Part II Created 1972	The county commission has the option to serve as the Authority Board; if they choose not to serve in full, they must appoint one member from each county commission district. They have not met and it exists only in statute.
BROWARD Ch. 348 Part III Created 1983	5 MEMBERS – 2 are appointed by the Governor, one of whom must be an elected municipal official for the entire appointment and the other who must not be an office holder; 3 are appointed by the county commission, and only 1 of the 3 may be a member of the county commission. Still in statutes but dismantled shortly after the Turnpike bought the Sawgrass Expressway in 1990.
TAMPA-HILLSBOROUGH Ch. 348 Part IV Created 1963	7 MEMBERS – 4 appointed by the Governor, the mayor (or designee) from the largest city in the county serving ex officio (because of the office) and with voting powers, one who is a member of the county commission serving ex officio (because of the office) and with voting powers, and the district DOT secretaries serving ex officio and with voting powers.
ORLANDO - ORANGE Ch. 348 Part V Created 1963	5 MEMBERS – 3 appointed by the Governor who are citizens of Orange County, chair of the county commission serving ex officio and voting, district DOT secretary serving ex officio and voting. Except as set forth, no member may be an officer or employee of any city within Orange County or of Orange County.
PASCO Ch. 348 Part VI Created 1973	The Pasco County Commission serves as the Authority Board. There has been no activity from them for approximately five years.
ST. LUCIE EXPRESS WAY AND BRIDGE AUTHORITY Ch. 348 Part VII Created 1983	9 MEMBERS – 2 shall be members of the Ft. Pierce City Commission, 2 shall be members of the city council of Port St. Lucie, 2 shall be county commissioners, and 3 shall be appointed by the Governor. No officer or employee of any city in or of St. Lucie County, except as set forth, shall be appointed.
SEMINOLE	7 MEMBERS – 5 are County Commissioners, 2 are municipal appointees; however, the Florida

Ch. 348, Part VIII Created 1974	Turnpike Enterprise has taken over the affairs of the Seminole Expressway Authority.
SANTA ROSA BAY BRIDGE AUTHORITY Ch. 348 Part IX Created 1984	7 MEMBERS – 3 appointed by the Governor, 3 appointed by the county commission (none of these 6 may be an elected official at the time of appointment), and the district DOT secretary.
SOUTHWEST FLORIDA EXPRESSWAY AUTHORITY Ch. 348 Part X Created 2005	8 MEMBERS- 7 voting appointed as follows: Governor appoints one Collier and one Lee resident from list of submitted by each county commission for its respective county, each county commission also chooses one of its members and one of its county residents who is not elected or a county or city employee, and the E.D. of the SW Florida Regional Planning Council. Non-voting members the FDOT District Secretary.
JACKSONVILLE Ch. 349 Created 1955	7 MEMBERS – 3 appointed by the Governor, 3 appointed by the Mayor, and the district DOT secretary.
NW FLORIDA TRANSPORTATION CORRIDOR AUTHORITY Ch. 343 Part IV Created 2005	9 MEMBERS-8 appointed by the Governor as voting members (one each from Escambia, Santa Rosa, Walton, Okaloosa, Bay, Gulf, Franklin & Wakulla Counties) and the District Secretary as a non-voting member.
