MARCOS R. MARCHENA is the senior partner of Marchena and Graham, P.A. a law firm located in Orlando, Florida. The law firm he founded in 1988 currently has seven attorneys practicing in the areas of commercial transactions, commercial litigation, real estate and government law.

Marcos was born in Cienfuegos, Cuba. He immigrated to the U.S. in February of 1971 and moved to Orlando in August of that year. Marcos is married to Nancy and they have three daughters.

Marcos received a Bachelor of Arts degree in Political Science from the University of Central Florida. Marcos graduated cum laude from Stetson University College of Law with a Juris Doctor degree. He has been a member of the Bar of the State of Florida since 1985 and is also a member of the United States Court of Appeal for the Eleventh Circuit and the United States District Courts for the Middle, Northern and Southern Districts of Florida.

Marcos has maintained an active civic life outside of his law practice. He was appointed by Senator Mel Martinez to chair the Middle District Federal Nominating Committee. He was also recently reappointed by Governor Charlie Crist to the Florida Transportation Commission. Mr. Marchena serves on the Board for the Central Florida YMCA, and on the Board of the Hispanic Business Initiative Fund. He is the past President of the Cuban Club of Orlando and a past Chairman of the Nominating Board of the City of Orlando, a past Chairman of the Orange County Planning and Zoning Commission, and a past Chairman of the Board of Trustees of Valencia Community College.

In 1997 the Orlando Business Journal selected Marcos one of the top 40 community leaders under 40 years of age. In 2004 he was recognized as one of the 10 top businessmen in Central Florida, and was also named to the Florida Legal Elite by Florida Trend Magazine.
