Dear Governor Crist:

Much like the canaries used long ago by coal miners to warn of impending danger, the recent tragic bridge collapse in Minneapolis has focused attention on the fact that we've chronically under-funded our transportation infrastructure. With a Special Session on the Budget slated to begin soon, you and the Florida Legislature have an opportunity to heed this warning and take steps to Move Florida Forward. Specifically, we at Floridians for Better Transportation (FBT) ask that you:

- 1.) Remove from consideration the \$79.6 million Transportation Trust Fund diversion currently targeted – or any transportation funding diversion,
- 2.) Work with Legislators to identify \$500 million in ready-to-go transportation projects that can be immediately funded using non-recurring dollars, and
- 3.) Agree with Senate President Pruitt and House Speaker Rubio to appoint a high level task force to consider and recommend alternatives to the state gas tax for funding Florida's expanding transportation needs.
